She has also been a frequent voice at the Colorado State Capitol, providing testimony on legislation affecting preborn children and their families.

Throughout her career, Neeley has demonstrated a passion for serving vulnerable populations. In addition to her pro-life advocacy, she has worked extensively with individuals experiencing homelessness, coordinated outreach efforts within her community, and regularly serves elderly residents through volunteer ministry. Her leadership reflects a consistent commitment to protecting and honoring life at every stage.

Neeley holds a Master of Science in Natural Health and is a Certified Holistic Health Practitioner (CHHP).

As Executive Director, Neeley will focus on strengthening partnerships across Colorado's pro-life movement, expanding grassroots engagement, equipping local communities for advocacy, and fostering collaboration among churches, pregnancy centers, ministries, businesses, and policymakers.

"I am honored and humbled to serve as Executive Director of Pro Life Colorado," said Neeley. "I believe this role is a calling. Colorado's pro-life community is filled with dedicated people and organizations already doing incredible work. My goal is to help bring greater unity, coordination, and effectiveness to those efforts as we work together to build a culture that values and protects
